PAST PRESIDENT'S PARLEY SCHOLARSHIP

RULES

1. Candidates shall be residents of Texas, child, grandchild, or great grandchild of a veteran in their own right who served in the Armed Forces during the eligibility dates for membership in The American Legion and plan to attend a Texas Educational Institution.
 - a. April 6, 1917 through November 11, 1918 (WWI)
 - b. December 7, 1941 through December 31, 1946 (WWII)
 - c. June 25, 1950 through January 31, 1955 (Korea)
 - d. February 28, 1961 through May 7, 1975 (Vietnam)
 - e. August 24, 1982 through July 31, 1984 (Grenada/Lebanon)
 - f. December 20, 1989 through January 31, 1990 (Panama)
 - g. August 2, 1990 to the date of cessation of hostilities (Persian Gulf)
2. Selection of recipients shall be based upon need, goal, character, citizenship and objective.
3. Application must be secured from the Auxiliary Unit in the community in which the applicant resides.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. A letter from applicant stating qualification and intentions.
2. Three (3) letters of recommendations:
 - a. Clergyman of the applicant's choice
 - b. Two (2) from representative citizens certifying to the applicant's character.
3. The complete application packet must be returned to the Auxiliary Unit prior to April 15, 2008.
4. Each unit winner's application packet must be received **NO LATER** than May 1, 2008. Medical Scholarship application are to be mailed to:

FINAL DETERMINATIONS SHALL BE VESTED IN THE PAST PRESIDENT'S PARLEY CHAIRMAN AND HER COMMITTEE AT THE ANNUAL STATE CONVENTION AND CHECKS WILL BE MAILED TO THE COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY THE APPLICANT WILL BE ATTENDING. IF APPLICANT DECIDES NOT TO ATTEND, MONEYS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY.
