

POPPY FUNDS

CAN BE USED

- For rehabilitation of all veterans honorably discharged from US Armed Forces after April 6, 1917
- For the welfare of families of veterans honorably discharged from US Armed Forces after April 6, 1917
- For the rehabilitation of hospitalized military service personnel returning home and awaiting discharge who require treatment in service hospitals
- For transportation expenses of volunteer hospital workers and the purchase of volunteer hospital workers' uniforms, if a department of the American Legion Auxiliary so desires
- To defray the expenses of Children and Youth Chairpersons in attending approved conferences at which they are approved representatives, and the expenses of the Deputy National Veterans Affairs Voluntary Services Representative to attend approved conferences and to defray administrative expenses of service officers, provided that both The American Legion and the American Legion Auxiliary departments approve such use of funds within the Department

CAN'T BE USED

- For any community service project that is not strictly for the veteran or the welfare of his/her family
- As investment to bring profit to the unit
- For active duty military programs
- For POW/MIA programs
- For Gold Star Mothers' memberships
- For Auxiliary Emergency Fund
- For making contributions to charities for research foundations
- Girls' State fees
- General Fund contributions
- Post or Unit beautification projects (i.e. flowers/plants, bar stools, benches)
- General maintenance
- Shipping items to active duty military
- Flag/pole for cemetery
- For scholarships where the eligibility does not specify veterans or their children
